Date wise brief Report for each of the five days FDP program is given below:

Day1: 11-10-2022

Session 1

Therefore after tea break the first session started with welcome of Dr. Sunayana Jain, Scrum Mater, talked about research methodology and highlighted of the accelerator based research and its significance over conventional techniques. She also shared her views regarding patience, hard work & perseverance required for undertaking research. She also focused a few very important aspects to be considered during research. She gave an idea about reasoning i.e. induction & deduction, hypothesis, variables, etc.

After the lunch, Dr. Varun Saxena, Assistant Professor, Jawaharlal Nehru University, Delhi, talked about the importance of advanced tools and techniques for writing a reputed research paper and how can the author select the higher indexing journal for paper publication. He tried to clear doubts regarding LR i.e. how to start LR, which articles to consider, how to cover it in a thesis, different styles of citations, etc. He also focused on steps to be followed in the formulation of a research problem with a few practical examples & covered what to consider in selecting a research problem

Day2: 12-10-2022

Session 1

The second day started off with the lecture of Dr. Sachin Taran, Assistant Professor from Delhi Technical University, Delhi. His talk was based on wireless technology and sensor optimization research which helps to show that how advanced level of equation for developing the wireless device and how it can be helpful for different equipments used in our life style. He tried to differentiate exploratory design with conclusive one. The objective of the exploratory study is to search/ explore & to provide an understanding of the problem at hand and give valuable insights. He explained that it cannot be used for generalization purposes, and thus, can't be effective for decision making. Participants discussed over various aspects with the speaker and the discussion continued during the lunch break.

After the lunch, Dr. Varun Saxena, Assistant Professor, Jawaharlal Nehru University, Delhi, again presented how the simple open source software can design a systematic research paper without plag. He also highlighted key repetitive & general questions asked during Ph.D. Defense in addition to more specific doubts with examples. He shared the importance of Preparation, Practice, and Skills development and performance rehearsal in defending Viva. He also explained how to frame & conduct a conclusive research design.

Day3: 13-10-2022

Session 1

The third day started off with the lecture of Prof. (Dr.) Nihar Ranjan Roy, Professor, Sharda University. delivered a talk on popular research based authoring tools and their efficient usage (equation numbering, citation & cross referencing, referencing, captioning, footnote, document layouts) using Microsoft word and latex. Referencing was demonstrated using Ms Word, JabRef, and BibTex. It also included demo of supporting tools for graphing & plotting (matlab), drawing (inkscape and draw.io), and plagiarism tools (turnitin). Last phase of the session include demo of symbolic mathematic tool in matlab, some effective tips on plotting. Due to shortage of time, What couldnot be covered was; demo on ns2 and Google colab. The Discussion with participants also included commercial available softwares and their open source counterparts.

Therefore after lunch break the session started with welcome of, Prof. (Dr.) Ambuj Agrawal, Professor, Sharda University. He talked about research based software and methodologies and its importance for designing the good quality paper to get the higher index in reputed journal or conference. He started with an example posing a sampling issue. He covered various types of designs relating to sampling issues & how to handle those. . Hands-on experience in a lab equipped with pre-installed SPSS was provided to participants. They practiced running t-test, ANOVA, regression & multivariate analysis on SPSS software.

Session 1

The fourth day started off with the lecture of Dr. Shivani Jain, Data Analyst, AICTE Delhi. She oriented participants to basics of Econometrics, for which objectives it could be used & introduced Software Eviews used for the analysis of Economic data by a technical round of session. She also covered basics of scale development & steps for designing better measures. She stressed the importance of literature review, Focus group, and Expert interview in scale development. The session covered how reliability & validity of the developed scale could be checked.

Session 1

At the last day of FDP, in first session, Ms. Madhu Bajpai, CEO, RIMUS Technologies, Noida presented important of tools and techniques for protecting secret data with higher authentication by using cryptographical methods. She also stated that malware and ransomware are the major threats for the devices. Malware is the cyber attack that misplaces the files, personal information from the laptop while ransomware can be considered as a data kidnapping that locks down the laptop and asks for the bribe in the form of bit coins to recover all the data. She also explained cyber crimes by giving some examples like bank frauds, attack of 26/11, blackmailing, destroying someone's personal integrity.

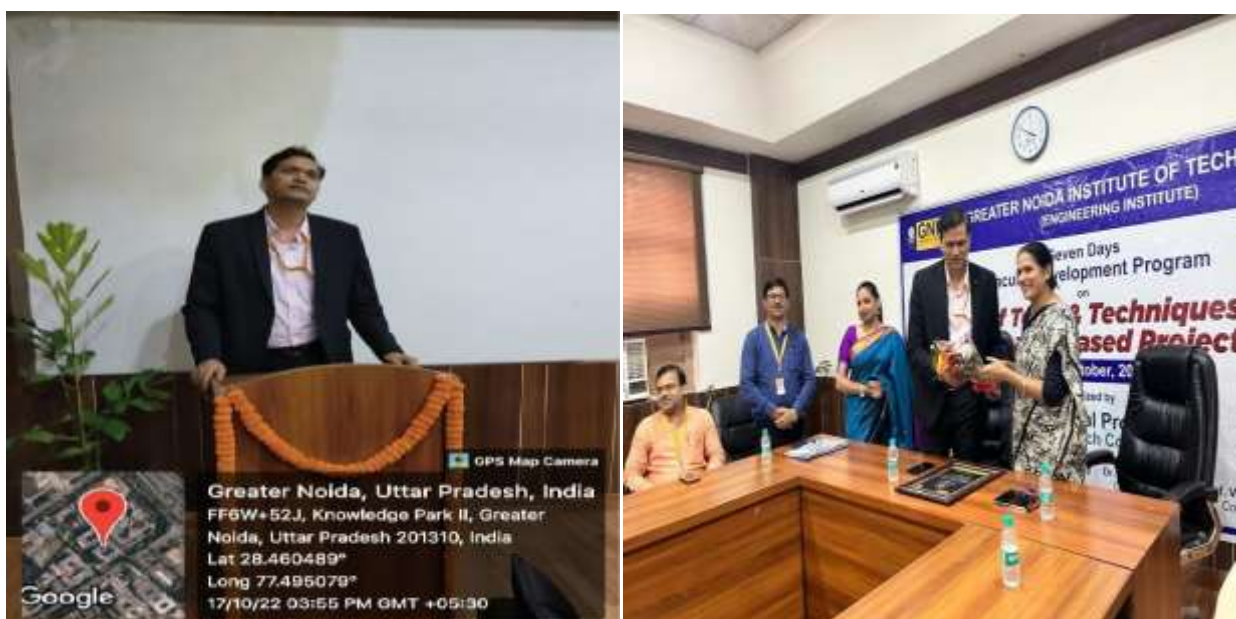
Valedictory & Certificate Distribution at the concluding session
