Dear Sir,

This is to bring under your kind consideration that as an affiliated institution, we follow all University norms including the curriculum which is in compliance with AICTE. We understand that Dr APJ AKTU curriculum includes all the essential core courses that are crucial for competitive exams and placements and is regularly updated to meet industry requirements.

As part of an institutional process, we have collected curriculum related feedback from major stakeholders - students, parents, alumni, faculty members, and employers. On the basis of the input received from this feedback, we wish to put forth some recommendations that may be included in the AKTU curriculum in the next academic session 2020-21. The recommendations are summarized as follows:

1. **Common for all engineering branches:** Microsoft Training Program may be included in the curriculum for all branches as it will be useful to students in their workplace.
2. **B.Tech Computer Science & Engineering and B.Tech Information Technology:** Courses related to Data Science may be included in the syllabus, based on growing demands of the industry.
3. **B.Tech Electronics & Communication Engineering:** A course on Electromagnetic Field Theory may be added to the curriculum.
4. **B.Tech Civil Engineering:** A theory course on Open Channel Flow may be included in the syllabus.
