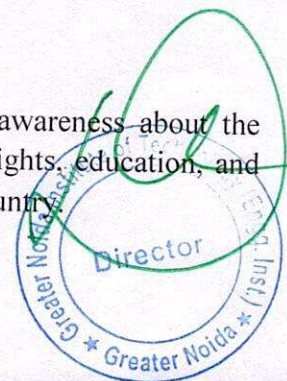
"Little Girls with Dreams become women with Vision"

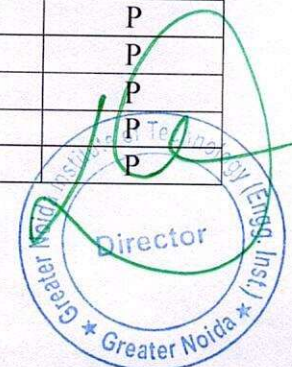
Impact:

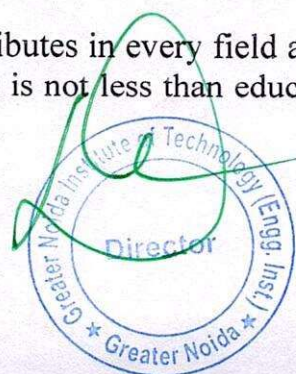
“Education is the only key to empower girls.”

Hod, IT Dr. Manoj Singhal Sir shared his views regarding the Girl Education and Hygiene and inspired students to promote it at their best.

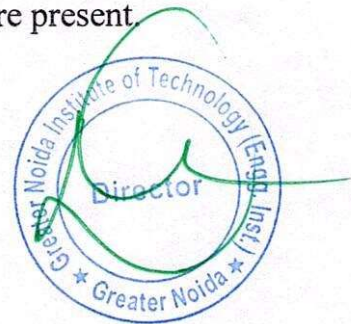

3. Girl Education will help them to understand the importance of hygiene.

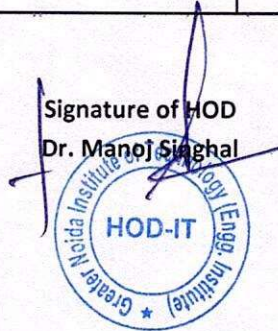
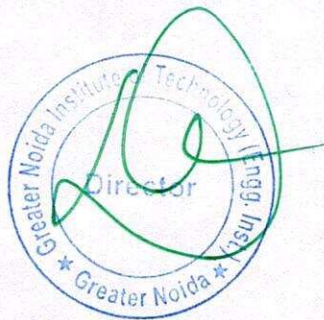

Summary Report: Dengue Prevention Awareness

The Computer Science & Engineering Department successfully organized "Dengue Prevention Awareness" activity in the college campus on 28-09-2019. The students were made aware of the measures and practices to prevent the spread of Dengue.

The Dengue Prevention Awareness event took place on 28th Sep, 2019 at GNIOT, Gr. Noida Campus. Dr. Vishal Sharma, the speaker at the event, discussed the seriousness of dengue fever and the measures that can be taken to prevent its spread. He highlighted the symptoms of dengue fever, including high fever, severe headache, joint pain, and rash, and emphasized the importance of seeking medical attention immediately if any of these symptoms occur. Dr. Sharma also discussed how dengue fever can lead to severe complications, such as dengue haemorrhagic fever or dengue shock syndrome, which can be life-threatening. Village: "Let Me See the World"**

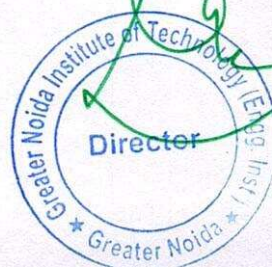

Report on Hygiene maintenance

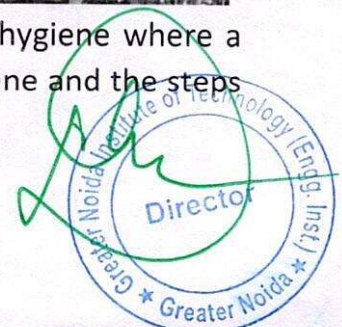

that individuals can take to maintain good hygiene. The speaker also talked about the impact of poor hygiene on health and the measures that can be taken to prevent the spread of diseases.


